Library Services Available to College Place Residents

College Place residents have two comprehensive library services available to them: the Walla Walla Public Library and the Walla Walla County Rural Library District.

Both libraries offer a multitude of resources and services, including the following:

- Books, movies, audio books, and eBooks available for checkout and download.
- Public-use computers with internet access.
- Online research databases including language learning, auto repair, student research, genealogy, and many other topics.
- Story times for children and their families.
- Arts and crafts events.
- Online account access to manage your due dates, request books, renew checked out items, etc., all from your own home computer.
- Spanish resources.

The Walla Walla Public Library also offers their series of “Big Idea Talks” programs which cover topics pertinent to the Walla Walla Valley, a book club, and a youth summer reading program.

The Walla Walla County Rural Library District offers a variety of programs at their 5 different locations including Loteria (Spanish Bingo), Family Movie Nights, and Homework Zone.

IRRIGATION SYSTEM OWNERS

This is just a reminder that State Law and City Code require that all backflow assemblies be tested by an approved assembly tester. The City will be mailing out reminder notices this spring to those who have an assembly that needs to be tested. A list of approved testers is included with the notice letter or you can go to the City's website on the residential services page under Public Works/Engineering. We appreciate your cooperation in completing the testing of your backflow assembly. The backflow assembly is an integral part of protecting the City's water supply.
