We now have a drivable thoroughfare that adds both beauty and functionality to our city. Still, there is work to be done which will continue to take place through this winter and into next spring.

2017 is an important year for the City. Our comprehensive plan will be updated in 2017. This plan provides the overall guidance on how and where the City will be developed, lays out our zoning, plans for street improvement, establishes requirements for our City's parks, how we'll deal with issues around environmental quality and a myriad of other functions for at least the next 10 years. The City's Planning Commission has the job of developing and coordinating the development of the Comprehensive Plan.
