MAYOR'S MESSAGE

Spring is a time of change in the Walla Walla Valley and we are experiencing big changes in the City of College Place. Roads, of course, are changing, but so are key personnel.

I want to welcome Larry Dickerson (not our city councilman, but another fine gentleman of the same name) from Goldendale, WA, who is our interim police chief. He has been on the scene since the beginning of April, has brought invaluable experience from his many decades of police work in the northwest, and is helping us while we mount a search for a new chief.

Dickerson recently mentioned that he loves "the natural beauty of the area – the Blue Mountains and rolling hills are even more striking than the Cascades."

He also described the citizen-police department involvement that is possible for police in a smaller community. "The officers here still help people who are locked out, or need assistance with code enforcement in their neighborhood; in larger cities there is very little time spent on issues like this and it makes a city and its police force more of a team," said Dickerson.

I also want to thank Pat Reay, our city administrator for his 12 years of excellent service to the city. We are going to miss him, but we are also very proud of his work and reputation that made him a unanimous selection against a very qualified field competing to be the new director of the Port of Walla Walla. We are so glad that if he had to go, he chose to stay close by.
